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Instructions

- ❑ This application is for federal CDBG and local Human Service funding for fiscal year 2012-2013.
- ❑ Applicants for federal CDBG funds must be recognized by the IRS as non-profit organizations and in good standing with the State of California; or be a division of local government.
- ❑ The project or program to be funded by the City’s CDBG Human Service Program must meet at least one of the following eligibility requirements: (A) benefit low, very low, or extremely low income persons; or (B) serve a group primarily presumed to be LMI (low and moderate-income persons) such as abused children, battered spouses, elderly persons, severely disabled adults, homeless persons, illiterate adults, persons living with AIDS and migrant farm workers.

The chart below shows upper income limits by household size, which define low, very low and extremely low income eligibility:

- ❑ Requests for funding must be for services or projects that will benefit residents who reside in the City of Lompoc. (This excludes Mesa Oaks, Mission Hills, Vandenberg Village and rural areas of the Lompoc Valley.) Location of projects is *not* restricted to within the City limits.
- ❑ A separate application is to be completed for each program proposed for funding.
- ❑ Tables in application are to be completed. Substitutions will not be accepted.
- ❑ Submit one (1) original application signed by an authorized agent AND ten (10) unstapled, paper clipped copies of the signed original (**11** total copies of your agency’s application). (Only one copy of required attachments please.)
- ❑ Include a blank copy of your current Client Intake Form. (**IMPORTANT!** If your program is selected for CDBG funding, funding by the City will be conditioned upon your agency collecting HUD required ethnic, racial, income, and female head of household data in formats prescribed by HUD.)
- ❑ Please review the required list of attachments shown on Page 12. If the attachment sent is not current, please explain why. If you believe your agency has previously submitted these documents to the Lompoc CDBG Program staff, please contact Chanel Navarro at 875-8041 to confirm that we have them on file.
- ❑ All agencies will be subject to announced and unannounced site visits.
